



# Community Health Worker Communication & Outreach Services (CHWCOS)

UPAC's Community Health Workers provide culturally and linguistically appropriate COVID-19 information and resources to Native Hawaiian Pacific Islander & Asian populations. CHWCOS is funded by the County of San Diego in support of the Live Well San Diego vision for safe, healthy and thriving communities.

## Services Provided:

- **Vaccine Assistance**— Our staff can schedule COVID-19 vaccinations for individuals in eligible tiers (*in-person and via phone*). We also offer in-person accompaniment at COVID-19 testing and vaccination appointments to provide translation and support.
- **COVID-19 Education & Outreach**— Our Community Health Workers are available to speak to groups in person, table at outdoor events and host online education sessions.
- **Printed Materials**— We can provide multilingual printed materials from the County of San Diego, CA state and CDC including COVID-19 info and community resources.
- **PPE**— We have a limited supply of free PPE such as hand sanitizer, face masks, etc.
